3.2 Safety trainers and Advisors

As a safety trainer and or advisor, you may create a profile that includes your contact information, areas of expertise, and other relevant details. You agree to provide accurate and up-to-date information and to inform us of any changes.

3.3 Fees and Payments

Directory users can reach out to trainers, advisors and organizations listed to discuss availability, scope of work, and fees for specific services, ACOS Alliance does not manage or receive payments in any form.

4. Data Protection and Privacy Policy

4.1 Data Collection

We collect personal data from safety trainers and advisors to facilitate connections and improve the Directory. This data may include names, contact information, areas of expertise, and other relevant details.

4.2 Data Usage

Your personal data will be used solely for the purpose of connecting journalists, news organizations with safety trainers and advisors. It will not be shared with third parties without your explicit consent.

4.3 Data Security

We implement appropriate organizational measures to protect your personal data from unauthorized access, loss, or misuse. We comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and prioritize the confidentiality and security of your information.

4.4 Data Retention

We will retain your personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this policy or as required by law. You may request the deletion of your data at any time.
